

How to make a clothespin Flytrap Puppet

For this craft, you will be making a flytrap puppet and an insect to glue onto your flytrap!



Materials needed:

- 1 clothespin
- Craft glue
- Construction paper or paper plate
- Scissors
- Crayons or markers
- Black pipe cleaners
- Different colored fuzzball
- Small googly eyes

Flytrap Puppet instructions:

-Draw an outline of two Venus Flytrap leaves on construction paper or a paper plate. You may also use regular white paper if you have it. Make one slightly larger than the other. The larger one will be the back of the flytrap.

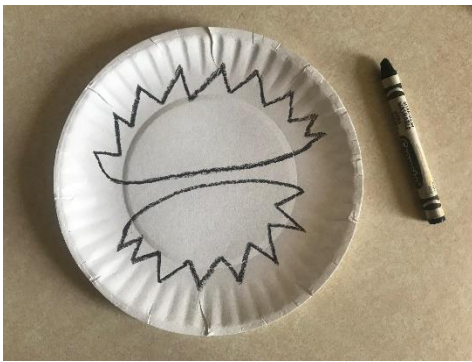
-Cut them out.

-Color your **little** leaf green and the **big** leaf red.

-Using the craft glue, glue your **little** green leaf onto the **front** of the clothespin.

-Glue the **big** red leaf to the **back** of the clothespin. They should open and close, like the trap of a venus flytrap!

Insect instructions:

-Take a black pipe cleaner and twist it around your smallest finger to make a spiral, this will be the body of your insect.

-At one end of the pipe cleaner, glue a small fuzz ball. This will be the head of your insect.

-On the fuzz ball, glue two googly eyes.

-Once your flytrap has completely dried, you can glue your insect onto one of the leaves!
